

## iiNet Launches ADSL2 With Speeds of up to 12000 kbps

**10 June, 2005** – iiNet Limited (ASX: IIN) today announced that it is delivering ADSL2, a new standard of ADSL broadband, which enables speeds of up to 12000 kbps. The faster speeds allow for effective transmission of data, voice and video over the Internet, often referred to as “triple play.”

iiNet and OzEmail customers currently connected to an exchange which is enabled with special iiNet equipment called a DSLAM will have their broadband speed upgraded from ADSL1, with speeds up to 8000 kbps, to ADSL2, free of charge over the coming days.

The DSLAM is hardware technology installed into local telephone exchanges, enabling iiNet to provide improved service functionality and much faster speeds. iiNet currently has over 28,000 customers connected to its DSLAM network, and is enabling an additional 100 exchanges by the end of the year.

With speeds of up to 12000 kbps, ADSL2 enables customers to use the Internet for more content-rich activities such as streaming movie trailers, pay-to-play music downloads online gaming, and voice over Internet functions. The actual ADSL2 speed a customer receives is dependant on the distance from the telephone exchange, the quality of the copper wire, and the router or modem the customer is using.

“Building our DSL network enables us to deliver the fastest broadband service possible, at no extra cost to customers” said Greg Bader, Chief Technology Officer, iiNet Ltd. “Our national trials of ADSL2 were very pleasing, with many customers receiving greatly enhanced speeds which naturally depends on things like distance from the exchange, line quality and the type of ADSL hardware being used in the home. And it will just keep getting better when customers choose to upgrade their hardware to take advantage of the new ADSL2 and 2+ standards” said Bader.

iiNet is the only Australian ISP currently rolling out large scale upgrades to the new ADSL2 standard and is already trialing ADSL2+, which will provide speeds of up to 24000 kbps. iiNet expects to launch ADSL2+ to customers in the coming months.
